 - b. Gambler's Choice – Eight fences judged on points accumulated for each fence. Joker fence is set 3" higher. Time to count.

Directions to Deer Haven Farm

From Washington, DC/Fairfax/Prince William

Take I-66 West to Marshall Exit 27
Turn Left at the end of the ramp onto Free State Road.
Take first Right onto Crest Hill Road (Rte. 647). Follow for about 6 miles.
Take a Left onto Wilson Road, go about ½ mile and turn Right onto John Barton Payne (Elysian Hills Training Center will be on your Left).
Continue on John Barton Payne for about 3 miles, as you approach the Village of Orlean, take a Left onto Cliff Mills Road. Follow for 1.5 miles and take a Left onto Owl Lane (gravel road).
We are the 2nd driveway on the right.

From Warrenton/Culpeper (Route 29)

From Business 29, take 211 West (towards Sperryville) for approximately 5 miles. Take a Right onto Leeds Manor Road (you will see a sign for Orlean and Hume). Stay on Leeds Manor for 6 miles. Take a Right onto John Barton Payne (Orlean Market will be on the corner), and then another Right onto Cliff Mills Road. Follow for 1.5 miles. Take a left onto Owl Lane. We are the 2nd driveway on the right.

DIRECTIONS TO FANCY FOX FARM

From Warrenton

Take Rt.211W for 5 miles. Turn left onto 229S towards Culpeper and go for 7.5 miles. Turn right at Ma & Pa's store onto Rt. 640 (Monument Mills Rd). Go 2.2 miles. Turn left onto Rt. 628 (Hazel River Rd.). Go 1 mile. Turn left onto Rt. 629 (Settle School Rd.). Go 2.2 miles and turn left into driveway of Fancy Fox Farm (Crestwood Lane).

RELEASE OF LIABILITY AND AGREEMENT OF ENTRY:

Every entry at this competition shall constitute agreement and affirmation that all participants (including owner, lessee, trainer, rider, handler and the horse) for themselves and their agents (1) shall be subject to the local rules of the competition; (2) represent that every horse and rider is eligible as entered (3) agree to be bound by the rules of the competition, and will accept as final the decision of the Ground Jury on any question arising under said rules, and agree to hold the competition harmless for any action taken and (4) agree that they participate voluntarily in the competition fully aware that horse sports and the competition involve inherent dangerous risk of serious injury or death, and by participating they expressly assume any and all risks of injury and loss, and they agree to indemnify and hold the competition and their officials, employees and agents harmless from and against all claims including for any injury or loss suffered during or in connection with the competition, whether or not such injury or loss resulted, directly or indirectly, from the negligent acts or omissions of said owners, officials, managers, employees or agents of this competition.

RELEASE: I understand that this is a high-risk sport and am participating at my own risk. I hereby assume this risk and further do hereby release and hold harmless the Organizer, the Organizing Committee, judges and officials, the host of this event and the owners of any property on which the event is to be held, from all liability from negligence resulting in accidents, damage, injury or illness to myself and to my property, including the horse or horses which I will compete at this event or trial.
