Only Chapter Treasurers should send chapter checks for dues made out to National OPRC.

OPRC Membership: The OPRC has a National Office located in Hollywood, Maryland and OPRC Chapters located throughout the United States. To join the OPRC, you join an OPRC Chapter that subsequently registers you with the National OPRC - the chapter membership coordinator enters the information from this Membership Form into the National database and the Chapter Treasurer or Membership Coordinator then sends your \$15 National OPRC dues (included in the chapter dues) to the National OPRC Membership Coordinator. The National OPRC Membership Coordinator then informs you via email when you can print your membership card from our web portal. The Membership Card is proof of membership for other chapters with whom you may want to ride. Chapters have also used the cards for proof of membership for discounts at tack stores, feed stores, etc. OPRC membership is based on a calendar year (January - December) and is renewed by February 28 of each calendar year (renewal dues are \$20 if entered into the database after February 28). Members who join at any time during a calendar year must renew by February 28 of the next year to avoid the late registration penalty. New Members: Information about each OPRC Chapter is available on the OPRC web site (<https://maps.oldpeoplesridingclub.com/Chapters.aspx>). Provide this *National OPRC Membership Form, OPRC Activity Release Form* (download from OPRC web site), and chapter annual dues to your Chapter President.

Chapter Presidents: For each new or transfer member, enter the information on this form into the National Portal database (or have the chapter's membership Coordinator enter the information) and either mail or pay online the \$15 *National OPRC Dues* to the appropriate National membership coordinator. *National OPRC has gone green. Please keep all membership forms and releases with your local chapter.* The National OPRC dues fund the lawyer, the accountant, club insurance, National Rally, Special Projects, postage, etc. Checks are payable to OPRC. After receipt of the National OPRC dues, National OPRC Membership Cards, are downloadable from your member's portal.

Membership Questions: Email the National OPRC Membership Coordinators from the above-mentioned link.

Members agree to abide by and adhere to the policies and guidelines of OPRC to include the use of helmets, riding appropriate footwear, and medical armbands when participating as a chapter member in mounted events.
